TOTS AND PRE SYLLABUS

AGE 2-4

Our Tots and Pre-Syllabus students are invited to perform in one dance during the first half of the show.

These dances will be rehearsed during their regular classes, and in the final weeks leading up to the performance, additional full run and dress rehearsals will be scheduled.

Specific rehearsal times for the Tots and Pre-Syllabus will be

communicated, and they will always be supervised by our fully qualified and DBS-checked staff.

We understand that this may be your child's first show with us, so please feel free to reach out with any questions you may have.



PRE PRIMARY AND PRIMARIES

AGE 5 - 6

Each student is eligible to participate in three dances during the first half of the show: one in modern dance, one in tap, and one in ballet. Rehearsals will be held on Tuesday afternoons, and as the show date approaches, additional rehearsals will be necessary, including full runs and dress rehearsals. All students aged 6 and above are also welcome to join the Finale, provided they can attend the required rehearsals.



JUNIORS, PRE SENIORS AND SENIORS

AGE 6+

All students are eligible to perform in at least one routine for each dance subject they are enrolled in. However, many students will qualify to take part in additional dances, which may include the opening, grand finale, and production numbers. Typically, Ballet, Modern, Jazz, and Tap grades are combined to create show dances. Additionally, workshop classes in Irish, Contemporary, and Commercial styles will also contribute pieces for the performance.

REHEARSALS AND FEES



A complete show timetable will begin on Monday, April 27th, 2026. After you fill out the online registration form, you will receive a list of the dances your child can participate in, aligned with the show timetable.

At this time, invoices for the show term will also be sent, detailing the number of dances your child is involved in. The invoices for the term will be calculated based on the number of show dances at the same rates as our standard pricing structure.





Final production rehearsals at the studio will incur a nominal fee of £5 per student to account for the additional time required.

Starting from Saturday 11th July, no absences will be allowed. This rule applies to everyone; those who miss these mandatory rehearsals will not be able to take part in the show.

Tots, Pre Syllabus, and Primaries will not be needed on every day.


To ensure the safety and well-being of the children backstage at a show of this magnitude, we must have an adequate number of licensed chaperones. We require at least 15 volunteers for each performance to take on this important role. It is crucial that the children are cared for by professionals who have undergone a DBS check and received approval from the Local Authority. We would greatly appreciate parents applying for a chaperone license, which is valid for two years. Interested individuals should contact reception as soon as possible for all the necessary information. We will then schedule an appointment for a DBS check and the chaperone license application. Please be aware that **ONLY** licensed chaperones are permitted backstage, and this rule will be strictly enforced without exceptions!




Tickets are priced at £20, £18 concessions and go on sale from 8am - Monday 2nd March 2026.
